**Chair’s Report:**

Chair provided written report. [Scanned copy attached.] Chair highlights that 180 attendees plus are expected for the upcoming Libertarian Party of California. Kim Goldsworthy is to be the Parliamentarian for the State Convention. Mr. and Mrs. Ed and Alicia Clark are to speak on Saturday. Governor William Weld is to speak Saturday. It is reported CSPAN may want to broadcast though that appears to be a 50/50 proposition at this time. The Orange County Register is to have a reporter there. Efforts are under way to get a Press Telegram reporter there.

Bill Lopez asked that the camera not be direct at himself. At 8:13 p.m. Chair advised Mr. Lopez that LPLAC meetings are open to the public and as such members are allowed to videotape the proceedings. The chair also mentioned at various National Party, State Party, and County Party meetings there is videotaping conducted so videotaping is not an unusual practice. The Chair said he will allow the videotaping to continue. Bill Lopez began directing comments. Saying, "I do not want to be video taped. The Chair called Bill Lopez to order. Bill Lopez continued directing comments to Bruce Dovner saying, "Do not direct the camera to my face." Mr. Barnes advised the Chair that Mr. Dovner's behavior was more than documenting the meeting.

The Chair told Bruce Dovner to stop filming Bill Lopez so the meeting could continue. The Chair then directed the Secretary Dave Bowers, to include in the minutes the actions committed so they will become part of the official record.

Chair continued his report to ask that Members bring signs and such to the LPC Convention.

Vice Chair’s Report: Reports that the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce Chair came to speak to Region 63. Update on Tim2018.com run, the Sacramento Press Club did not invite Tim; therefore Tim has sent a letter to find out how they determined who to invite.
